Senior Researcher and Professor

Simon Cohen is currently Senior Researcher at the French institute of science and technology for transport, development and networks (IFSTTAR) and Professor at Ecole des Ponts ParisTech. He is director of the french **abertis chair** in Transport Infrastructure Management, since 2011. He studied at the University Pierre et Marie Curie (Paris VI), where he got his Phd in Applied Mathematics (Statistics and operations Research) in 1977.

Much of his career has been in the field of transportation research. His work focuses mainly on the area of advanced traffic management and intelligent transport systems for road networks. He is advisor of several theses and Master thesis.

In addition, he chaired the editorial board of the review '*Recherche Transport et Sécurité*' (RTS, 1998 to 2008). He is often referee for several international reviews on transportation research. He acts as expert, auditor or consultant on matters related to the assessment of Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) for national, european and international institutions, in both public and private sectors.

He is the author of a work on road traffic engineering, co-author of a book on the effects of speed limits, and author of many reports and publications. He has been awarded for research papers (Innovation prize in 1991), (Review RGRA in 1994), (TRB in 2011) or demonstration projects in road telematics (Accessit at PREDITT Program, 1998).
